What Makes us Unique

- Our classes help develop social skills, cognition, emotional growth, fine motor control, and concentration using musical activities.
- ISM teachers are musicians who are trained in early childhood educational methods. Our teachers are specially recruited because they are both passionate about child development and sensitive to each child's individual personality, talents, and needs.
- Children develop at different rates, particularly at this sensitive period. The motor skills of a 6 month old are vastly different from a 20 month old. Accordingly, we structure our classes to specific age groups.
- Our classes build skills. The ISM Magic of Music Program builds skills from one class to the next, preparing each child for eventual instrumental instruction.

	Fun & Lullabies	Age: 6 - 18 mo. Mon: 1:00 pm Wed: 10:00 am \$312	<p>This class is meant to be a learning and sharing experience for parents and infants through singing and movement appropriate for very young age groups. Sensitivity to sound begins at a very early age. Fun & Lullabies is a first learning experience for even the tiniest ears just learning to listen. It provides an opportunity for parents and their littlest ones to share songs, rhymes, and movement games in a nurturing, joyful setting.</p>	With Parent
	Toddler Tones	Age: 12 mo. - 3 yrs Mon: 10:30 am Tues: 4:30 pm Wed: 11:00 am Sat: 10:00 am \$312	<p>This class offers a musical experience any toddler will enjoy. It engages children through songs, chants and games that helps them to see music in their everyday world. As this class guides toddlers to co-operate with other children, they develop the co-ordination needed to play instruments, words to simple songs, recognition of different rhythms, and the ability to differentiate musical factors like pitch, volume, and time. Through improvisation, rhythm, play acting, movement, and song, this class will offer fun for your toddler & you.</p>	With Parent
	Color My Music	Age: 2 - 3 yrs Tues: 10:30 am Fri: 10:30 am \$312	<p>A follow-up to "Toddler Tones", this class takes advantage of its students' more mobile bodies with a higher emphasis in rhythmic exercises, dance, and games. These classes are filled with musical activities: students listen to stories, climb, jump, crawl, and use their imaginations in discovering the joy of music. Vocal exploration, call and response songs, movement, finger play and exposure to non-pitched instruments, make this class a wonderful musical experience.</p>	With Parent
	Music, Imagination, & Me	Age: 3 - 5 yrs Mon: 5:00 pm Wed: 4:30 pm Sat: 11:00 am \$312	<p>This class encourages developing minds to improvise and stretch their imaginations through music. What would wind sound like at the piano? Could a conjure picture in our minds, then use the piano and other percussion instruments to make our thoughts come to life. In this class, children will become more aware of pitch and rhythm, recognize the sound of different instruments, become more expressive through music, and develop more sophisticated movement to music.</p>	
	Musical Voyage	Age: 4 - 5 yrs Mon: 4:00 pm Wed: 1:00 pm or 5:30 pm Fri: 1:00 pm Sat: 12:00 pm \$312	<p>This class is designed to promote musical independence, and to boost cognitive understanding of music. Students enjoy partner activities, musical games, and continue work with more advanced concepts such as tempo, dynamics, and timbre. Rhythm, songs, and vocal patterns are continued, while children are encouraged to begin creating their own music through simple rhythmic patterns and melodies. The goal of this class is to nurture the musical intelligence of each child by providing opportunities to explore musical concepts through a variety of sounds, instruments and recordings.</p>	
	Instrument Explorers	Age: 4 - 5 yrs Thur: 5:00 pm Sat: 1:00 pm \$312	<p>What does it feel like to hold a violin in your hands? How do you make a sound on a guitar? Children learn about different instruments by seeing, touching, and hearing them. Each class session also includes a crafts portion in which children create real and imagined instruments. This class covers wind, percussion and string instruments. Additionally, these instruments are used to introduce melody and music notation. "Instrument Explorers" is a first introduction to musical instruments, in which they can discover their favorite for when they are ready to move to private instruction.</p>	
	Keyboard Kaleidoscope	Age: 4 - 6 yrs Tues: 5:45 pm Thursday: 4:00 pm \$312	<p>This is a first exploration of keyboard instruments where children are introduced to the building blocks of music: rhythm, pitch, note reading, and technique through playing games. By the end of the semester, children will be able to perform simple melodies on the piano. Class size is limited to 4. It is recommended that a student have access to a piano or keyboard outside of class to maximize their experience. This course is a one-semester course leading to private studio instruction.</p>	
	Singing, Fun, & Play	Age: 5 - 9 yrs Tues: 6:30 pm \$312	<p>Designed for children who love to sing, this class introduces students to fun warm-ups, vocal exercises, proper breathing, posture & simple repertoire. Musical selections include folk songs, children's rhymes, & simple choral literature suited to young voices.</p>
